(*Luke 10:30-37*)
  - That everyone is our neighbor
- 4. In the parable of the good Samaritan, what was the significance of the one who helped being a Samaritan?**  
(*John 4:9*)
  - The Jews hated the Samaritans, and would have no business with them
- 5. In the parable of the sower, what did the seeds that fell on the way side represent?**  
(*Matthew 13:3-9,18-23*)
  - Those that do not understand the word of God
- 6. In the parable of the sower, what did the seeds that fell in the stony places represent?**  
(*Matthew 13:3-9,18-23*)
